March is here and hopefully spring is on it's way! Spring is my favorite time of the year. I love the rebirth of the world with flowering trees, green grass, warmer temperatures, and of course baby farm animals. However, with all of these comes the rebirth of those pesky parasites – fleas, ticks, intestinal worms and of course there is always the threat of heartworms! In the past several years, we have noticed a significant increase in positive heartworm patients, and this is because of the decline in the number of pets that are on heartworm preventative. The truth is heartworm preventative of all kinds are a "prescribed" drug which means they are only available through your veterinarian or a legal pharmacy such as Petmeds or Chewy with a prescription for your pet from your veterinarian. So, in short, heartworm preventative cannot be bought over the counter or from another pharmacy without approval. They can be bought on Petmeds and other pharmacies; however, you must have a prescription from your veterinarian. On the other hand, flea and tick preventatives can be bought over the counter at Walmart and on the internet without a prescription. Even though from these places, there is no guarantee they will work or not harm your pet, but there is always a guarantee on the products sold at the vet clinic.



After having this happen multiple times, I realize everyone is confused about what products are used for preventing what parasites and I completely understand! There are hundreds of products out there on the market today and even I must look up some of the generic flea and tick products to know about them! The worst part is that people think they are protecting their fur babies from "deadly" heartworms when actually they are just preventing fleas and ticks, but they don't know it since heartworms are inside the body and can't be seen!

So, to help everyone out and make sure our fur babies are properly protected; here is a simple cheat sheet from Dr. Flanary.

- **Fleas** are external parasites that jump from one host to another. One bite from a single flea, your pet will become itchy. An overload of fleas on an animal can lead to anemia. Fleas also transmit tapeworms.
- <u>Ticks</u> are another external parasite. Disease-carrying ticks pose health risks to dogs and people, no matter where you live. Ticks can transmit Lyme disease, Rocky Mountain spotted fever and Ehrlichiosis. This infection is *VERYCOMMON* in our area.
- <u>Heartworms</u> are internal parasites. Heartworms are carried by mosquitoes and spread to dogs when bitten by the mosquitos. Dogs will not show signs until late in the course of the disease. Heartworms are fatal if left untreated.
- Roundworms, Whipworms and Hookworms are internal parasites that live in the GI tract. They are transmitted by contact with the feces of infected animals or from a mother to offspring. An overload of worms can cause diarrhea, anemia, and loss of body condition.
- <u>Tapeworms</u> are internal parasites that live in the GI tract. They are transmitted by ingestion of a flea or ingestion of dead small animal's carcasses such as mice. While no signs may be present some pets can have diarrhea, weight loss or poor body condition.



There are so many products on the market currently and it can be confusing on which product is best for your pet.

Take home message: Heartworm preventatives MUST get from a Veterinarian or have a script from a Veterinarian.

Flea & Tick Preventatives – safe brands that work with money back guarantee come from Veterinarians. Unsafe brands that do not work are sold over the counter.


